

TRAPUNTO BY MACHINE

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In this class our main objective is to learn the *technique* of “trapunto by machine”, but you will also be making either a small wall hanging or a pillow top (whichever you prefer). In order to have fun in this class, you should already have had at least a beginning machine quilting class and have basic knowledge of free motion quilting.

*I will be teaching you Hari Walner’s technique of Trapunto by Machine. She has two books on this subject and both are extremely good, well written books. Plus, they have lots of beautiful quilts and ideas to inspire you.

SUPPLIES: (you may either buy a kit, or bring ALL of the supplies listed below)

Kit Includes:

¾ yard of Ultra Sateen Fabric (by Robert Kaufmann)

1 spool Sulky Rayon Thread for Trapunto design

1 spool Superior Kimono Silk Thread (for background quilting)

1 spool Vanish Lite Wash-Away thread

Batting:

20”x20” cotton

20”x20” medium- high loft polyester

Needles:

1 70/10 quilting needle

1 80/12 quilting needle

You Must Bring the following:

Sewing machine in good working order. Please bring the sewing machine that you do your best work on. You **must** be able to lower the feed dogs for this class. (Sewing machines in which you can only *cover* the feed dogs do not usually work because of the extra batting in your quilt top.)

*Blue wash away marker; make sure it works well and is not old and dried out

*Scissors; small, sharp (i.e. not dull or nicked), but with a blunt tip. These will be used to trim away excess batting from the back of your quilt top and we don’t want sharp tipped scissors to poke a hole into the quilt top.

*Free Motion or Darning foot for your sewing machine

*Walking foot

*Approximately 50 safety pins

*Masking tape or painter’s tape (1” or wider)

*At least two empty bobbins
